

Help Keep Our Town Looking Clean

I have recently met with Waste Management (WM) concerning the large number of debris piles that are left all over Town. These piles make the Town look dirty. They have requested the following assistance.

- **Piles of normal size get picked up every Thursday. These are work on by WM staff with a truck and they load the piles by hand.**
- **If a pile is oversized, which most of the piles that we see sitting are, the resident needs to call WM at 321-723-4455 and ask for a special pickup due to size. There is no charge; however, it generates a work ticket and those are required to be handled within 7-10 days. Those tickets are given priority when the clam trucks are scheduled in an area. The more tickets in an area the more frequent we get the clam truck scheduled to our Town. Once the truck comes to our Town all the tickets are completed for this area and then the drivers go around picking up piles to fill the truck prior to going to the landfill. I hope you can see how the ticket is a much better way to go to get your piles removed.**
- **When you place the pile at roadside, take time to place them away from the ditch line so that when they are sitting waiting to be picked up, the debris does not blow back into the ditch. Remember, what falls into the ditch will be carried by the water and is a potential blocker at a culvert.**
