

**MALABAR PARK AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD

This Special meeting of the Malabar Park and Recreation Advisory Board was held at the Malabar Community Park, 1840 Malabar Road on this date. Meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by Chairman Kemmler.

**DISCUSSION:**

**FRDAP Grant – Dissect and Fine Tune Application for Pavilion and Bathroom Facility**

Members of the Park Board met at the large pavilion at the park to determine the location and type of bathroom to be built and where and how the new pavilion should be positioned and located. Mr. Withers wanted to pick two sites for the bathrooms, a primary site and an alternate site. The primary site is just west of the parking lot near the north end where the sand pile is. The front of the bathroom would face the parking lot still in view of the security cameras on the Fire Dept. The Park Board estimated the approximate cost to be \$60,000.

The alternate location for the restroom site would be at the end of the little league field at the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> base.

Mr. Withers also added that he would eventually like to add four more swings, two toddler swings and one more tire swing to the south end of the playground toward the little league field.

The new pavilion which would be located where the present large pavilion is now, would be approximately 40' by 50' in size, be constructed with 6x8 upright post, with a vented asphalt roof and a cement floor. The pavilion would be moved back toward the road somewhat and parallel to the open space. The Board agreed that it would be called the Grand Pavilion, so as not to confuse it with the large pavilion. The large pavilion will be relocated to another location in the park.

Vicki Thomas suggested that receptacles be placed up near the roof of the new pavilion at the bottom of the joist, so that decorative lights could be placed around the roof at Christmas time and other times. It was agreed that four single receptacles could be placed along the roof line for this purpose.
