MALABAR TOWN COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING

April 21, 2014 7:30 PM

This meeting of the Malabar Town Council was held at Town Hall at 2725 Malabar Road.

A. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 7:32 pm by Council Chair Steve Rivet. The prayer and pledge were led by Council Chair Steve Rivet.

B. ROLL CALL:

Clerk explained that CM Milucky was out of town on business and could not make it back for the meeting. For the record Fire Chief Christopher Robinson was also present.

F. ATTORNEY REPORT

Attorney gave update regarding lawsuit filed by Painted Acres. They have filed their second amended complaint, 3rd shot at it. FLC legal counsel has moved to dismiss. The case is in the process of getting a hearing date. There is no limit on how many times this can be resubmitted. He will keep TC apprized.

G. BREVARD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE REPORT - None present

H. MALABAR FIRE CHIEF: Nothing outside of what was submitted. TA said they will have several items on the next agenda. One is his car. Get rid of two and get one new one. Wayne said Chief found county wide discount. TA said the Chief will present a number of things at next meeting; one of which is the Chief's vehicle. Get rid of two vehicles that are costing us money and replacing them with one. Chief has done research and found a State procurement bid.

2. Recommendation from Park Board – Signage

Recommendation: Request Action

Park & Recreation Board Member Bill Sastrum explained what he is willing to do for Malabar's benefit. The frames he builds would have slot for sign page would slip in from the top. The parties sponsoring the event would be responsible for changing the signage; SpringFest, Tree Lighting, etc. It would be for Town Sponsored events. Town would still do maintenance, which should be little to none.

Marisa asked if the Park Board had decided where they should go. Bill said yes – at town hall, and at intersections of Weber and Corey at Malabar Road.

MOTION: Dick / Wayne to approve signage up to \$250.00 for three signs built by Bill Sastrum with MOU that the Parties involved with the events would be responsible for placement and removal of signs.

Vicki Thomas stepped forward as Chair of Park and Rec Board and wanted to praise Bill Sastrum for his initiative to build the sign frame work and also for the cabinet for the bell in front of the dais on display. The cabinet also provides a storage place when not on display. He also refurbished the bell. She said Scott Bishop gave her the bell and Bill cleaned it up and built the cabinet/stand. She thought it could be used/rung at Town events or when someone dies.

VOTE: All Ayes - 4; Nay - 0; Motion carried 4 to 0.

PRESENTATION – Atkins Engineering – Short Update on SR514 Project by Lance Decuir. There will be public meeting on May 6 at hospital auditorium from 5 to 7pm. Lance gave overview. They divided the project from Babcock to Highway 1 into three sections and then provided options for each section.

Section 1: Babcock to Weber - 4-lane Urban

Section 2: 4-lane Suburban from Weber to Marie w/ 148' right of way or the other option would be Rural design but that would require 182' right of way. Another option would be to make intersection improvements at Marie, Corey and Weber with no build past Corey.

Section 3: Marie St to US1. There studies there is no need for 4-lane in this area. Probably could have a 3-lane urban (70+' needed), sidewalks, bike paths and trail crossings. Also have a no build option on this segment.

After the May 6 meeting, they will come back to Council in another five months and have recommendations to present. He will have several different pond locations to share. This corridor is a Class 3 but they will try and make it a Class 5 so they can put in more openings / cut throughs on the median. He explained the shared driveway for FD Disc Park and Malabar Com Park. They will display matrix board to show how they evaluated the different impacts. The biggest environmental issue is the F-4 conservation lands. They are trying to come up with widening options that will minimize the impacts to the conservation lands.

He said there is no funding in place beyond the PD&E study. There is funding for safety improvements at Corey and that will start in October to add turn lanes on SR514 and also on Corey.

Wayne asked about using Glatter and Township. Lance said they looked at that but it can't be done.

Wayne also sees the traffic back-ups on Malabar at 8AM. Lance has done the traffic count. Counts were done before the work at Babcock and Malabar. This is also a hurricane evacuation route.

Dick said with the passenger train traffic, there will be 32 more trains crossing Malabar Road between 7AM-9PM. It is also difficult to get out onto Malabar from Weber if someone is trying to turn left ahead of you.

Marisa asked about the speed. Some will be reduced around Weber but not the rest.

Dick said SR514 is the only east/west in Brevard County with a 55mph. He thinks it is a very dangerous situation. Lance said he thinks it is because there is no development. Marisa said if our input is not listened to, then it is discouraged. She would like to come to meetings and know they are being listened to. Lance understands the issues. The safety improvements will help but he suggested council keep up the pressure on FDOT.

Dick said the BCSO deputies have told him that there they can't do many traffic stops because there is nowhere to pull over. Lance said improvements will help that because they will be widened.

Mayor said the 4-lane Urban should be continued to Marie Street. Mayor said the other issue, heading east and freight trains going across Malabar Road can stop traffic all the way back to the hospital. On the US1 they have traffic backed up all the way down Highway 1.

Other issue is with the crossing and double tracks, they will coordinate with the improvements. They have 18 freight trains and they go 65 mph.

Wayne if you are ever going to get the land, why not just do it now. Why not make it 4 lanes all the way through. He thinks it is not logical.

Marisa, Malabar Road is used monthly when traffic is detoured off I-95. Traffic is stacked up along Malabar Road. Also lots of people use Malabar Road as a short cut from Grant Valkaria up Corey and Weber Roads.

Franklin said she discussed this with Renee White and she felt that the CowBell would do better as part of the SpringFest event. Proposed 3/28 because the 4/4 date is the date before Easter. The weather should be better than 4/18 – too hot.

MOTION: Dick / Wayne to set date for SpringFest 2015 as 3/28/15 and the CowBell the same day in early afternoon. Approved by consensus.

5. Decision on Corrective Action re: W. Railroad Avenue

TA said they originally brought the ROW agreement as an easy resolution with the least amount of harm to the businesses. TC had no interest. They directed her to meet with owners and tell them

to buy the Lot 10. In trying to deal with this, buying the property does not solve the problem. She did contact Flagler Dev and they verbally told her 10K but when she asked for it in writing they want 12,500.00. She is uncomfortable with negotiating with them if Town is not the buyer. Also in order for this option to solve the problem, Dr. Ireland would have to dedicate the property to the Town. They have done a lot of research and spent a lot of time on this and discussed the best method to resolve the liability issue without a financial burden to the businesses. TA and Clerk met with Dr. Ireland this morning and went over the options. TA asked Clerk to speak.

Clerk said she met with the Town Surveyor Craig McKinnon on Friday afternoon. He also doesn't know how a person can take part of a platted right of way and move it but that is what happened in 1912. He also told her there were many other similar issues of encroachments into rights of way or survey errors. Requiring the property owner(s) to buy the 20' x 210' Lot 10 would not reduce the encroachment at all unless the property owner then dedicated it to the Town for ROW. Right of way cannot be given or sold. It can only be vacated by the agency having jurisdiction. This lot was created in 1912. From what Morris has determined it looks like it was made up of the eastern edge of Lots 1, 2 and 7 and the rest from the right of way.

In 2005 when Mr. Day and Mr. Cook bought the property, they pulled permits to demolish the ram shackled 2-story house and cleared out all the overgrowth and exotics. They wanted to market it for a commercial use. They asked the town if the platted E/W ROW could be vacated. Our engineer at the time said that in order for that request to go to Council they (Day & Cook) would have to dedicate additional ROW to the Town along W. RR Ave and also along Marshal Drive on the west side of their property. They dedicated 20' along W RR Ave to the Town. The Town did nothing with this additional ROW; we didn't clear it, stake it, fence it, or widen the roadway. Nothing has changed since that time. If the Town had not requested the additional ROW that we have done nothing with, AAA Storage's fence and trees would not be encroaching into the right of way. We approved the location of the trees and the fence. It was our error as much as theirs.

Staff strongly recommends that Council vacate the ROW known as W. RR Ave north of Malabar Road to its northern terminus while at the same time requiring the property owners to grant a 12' easement in perpetuity for ingress and egress of all property owners and their heirs that use that roadway as access to their land.

Once it is private, then the individual property owners can get together and make the improvements necessary for all their traffic to get thru there. Zackes Nursery has huge tractors with flat beds hold trees and the tree digger equipment. Heidekruger has well drilling equipment and trucks using the roadway. AAA Storage allows outside storage of vehicles and they enter and leave from this roadway. Kemphers has his deliveries made with large tractor trailers and they maneuver all over the private Lot 10 and the RR property to get turned around to unload. Clerk showed pictures on overhead.

TA said she and Clerk are frustrated because they want cure the encroachment but not cause economic hardship to any of these businesses. AAA Storage has offered to improve the road by bringing in material and having a contractor roll it out and tamp it. Right now if they want to improve the road they would have to follow town standards to build a "road" that would be accepted by Council for maintenance. If the Town makes him move the fence then he would also have to move the 17 trees we made him plant for landscaping compliance. It would not be simply a matter of moving them a little to the west because his storm water system is west of the existing tree line.

Wayne asked what happens if after they vacate the footage and then the railroad fences across Lot 10; that would be a problem as no one could access West Railroad Avenue. Wayne said it

may do Kempher's good to buy Lot 10 so that doesn't happen. The power pole is in the middle of the realigned right of way. That could be a problem.

Dick agrees, they are well aware of the location of the power pole. The power pole will be moved when the road is improved. Dick was here and saw how much work staff has done in trying to resolve this issue.

Dick does not see a downside to vacating. All other property owners would still have access.

TA said that is correct. Mr. Marks has been willing to improve it but can't if it is town ROW. Mayor said he had already talked with Attorney about eminent domain; he doesn't know if Council wants to do that or even if they can. The other issue is, he had Craig McKinnon explain to him once that if you maintain the roadway then you can claim the portion you have been maintaining. Attorney said you can do a map reservation if you can show the Town has maintained the roadway; you file the map with the clerk of court and it is just like adverse possession. Franklin said it has not been maintained by the Town in last many years any more than any other unimproved roadway - perhaps for life and safety. Carl said PW used to maintain it by grading and mowing and cutting back the pepper trees. Attorney doesn't know if we can prove we have maintained it consistently for the required period of time.

Attorney Bohne said the vacate and easement is the best way to go. Wayne said when they widen the road to three lanes where will they place power pole. Atty said if they widen then feed store may go away. Mayor doesn't mind pursuing this but he would like the Attorney to look at alternative ways to correct it. As he understands it if we vacate then half would go to each side. No, the easement would be made on the east side and the vacated portion will be on the west side. Wayne asked where the right of way would be vacated. Clerk showed on overhead.

Dick said we are rural community and have horses and they eat hay. We have two businesses that provide that and only one within town limits. TA said Mr. Ireland said that the sale of hay makes up 70% of his business. We have always wanted to help our businesses. If we tell him he has to remove the trailers then we might as well tell him to close down.

MOTION: Dick / Wayne to direct staff to prepare the vacate document while reserving an easement for ingress and egress.

Discussion: Chair recognized Speakers Card from Brian Vail. Vail said when FDOT does their widening project they will use eminent domain to get what they need. What prevents the Town from using eminent domain against the railroad for Lot 10? Attorney Bohne explained how the Feds can take from the State and the State can take from the municipalities but it does not work the other way. Franklin explained that the Charter was changed to eliminate the ability to do eminent domain in 2006. She doesn't know if they can still do it via another way. The Attorney said that looking at the picture of the tractor trailer; the rig is actually on private property. They are proposing to vacate 2' from Malabar Road north to the end of Dr. Ireland's property and then a wider distance from that point north to the end of AAA Storage property. Wayne asked about just keeping one trailer. Dick called for the question.
