# MALABAR TOWN COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING NOVEMBER 8, 2012 7:00 PM

This meeting of the Malabar Town Council was held at Town Hall at 2725 Malabar Road.

### A. CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor then read and presented a Certificate of Appreciation to outgoing Council Member District 2, David White. White said it had been a pleasure to work with staff and Council and work for the residents. He thanked everyone and said he may run again in the future.

Chair turned it over to Clerk.

Franklin stated for the record that prior to this evening's meeting Wayne Abare submitted a resignation letter from his seat on the Planning and Zoning Board.

Franklin explained that on November 6, 2012 there were elections held for the Mayor's seat, and Council seats in District 1, 2 and 3, and nine (9) ballots questions for Malabar.

The Brevard County Canvassing Board will meet on Friday November 9, 2012 for the Certification of the 1<sup>st</sup> Unofficial Results and Review of the Provisional Ballots. This will be held at the Supervisor of Election Viera Office and the meeting is open to the public.

This is the first year I did not watch the returns from the Elections Office in Viera. I followed the returns on the Supervisor of Elections Office website that was updated every five minutes.

The results as of 10:30PM Election night showed Precinct 301 at 100%.

The results show for:

Mayor, the unofficial report lists Carl Beatty as the winner.

District 1, the unofficial report lists Jim Milucky as the winner.

District 2, the unofficial report lists Wayne Abare as the winner.

District 3, the unofficial report lists Steve Rivet as the winner.

Ballot Question 1, binding: Continue with MSTU was approved

Ballot Questions 2 and 3, binding: Change Charter to regarding electors and petition requirement for candidates for Mayor was approved.

Ballot Question 4, binding: Discontinue Roll Call Vote for Resolutions was Rejected by voters.

Ballot Question 5, binding: Electronic Payment was approved

Ballot Questions 6, binding: 1 Mil for CIP was rejected by voters.

Ballot Questions 7, 8, 9, were also rejected by voters. (town hall, community ctr and riverfront)
