# MALABAR TRAILS AND GREENWAYS COMMITTEE REGULAR MEETING MINUTES September 6th, 2022, 6:00 PM

This meeting of the Malabar Trails and Greenways Committee was held at Town Hall at 2725 Malabar Road.

## 1. CALL TO ORDER, PRAYER AND PLEDGE:

Meeting called to order at 6:10 P.M. Prayer and Pledge led by Chair Thompson.

- 7. DISCUSSION

#### a. Trail, Kiosk and Firebreak Conditions

Chair Thompson showed some photos of trees that had been knocked over and rapidly cleared by the trail crew. CMs Schoolfield and Hann both participated in removing blocking trees from the trail. CM Hann states he saw 3 Scrub Jays high up in a sand pine tree near the entrance to the Cameron Preserve. He also noted a few down trees removed in the area between the bridges.

## b. Eagle's Nest Trailhead Discussion

Chair Thompson began by recapping the discussion of the last meeting. Chair recommend that the Committee move ahead to bring in fill and road base to be delivered in the center of the ENT. CM Hann asks if that is the right way to do it? Chair states he believes the Town does not have the staff to complete the process. If we can get the dirt in now, it may not be optimal, but it will be progress. CM Hann is concerned this is not the most efficient process. Chair states he wants to get dirt in the trailhead before it rains, or we lose the funds. If we have the dirt there, we can work at spreading it slowly with volunteer help. CM Wilbur states he is uneasy making plans that hinge on TOM PW assistance. CM Hann suggests bringing in the dirt now. CM Wilbur states a skid steer machine would be ideal for the spreading of the dirt. CM Harvey states she has access to a front-end loader. Secretary Kohler stated the motion from the last meeting would be sufficient to accomplish the discussed tasks. CM Hann estimates 38 loads at an 18-yard dump truck. He also estimated the cost as \$100 per trip for transport, and about \$100 for each load. 40

loads of fill should be inside the budget. CM Wilbur suggests having the trucks dump in the center of the area. Secretary Kohler informed the Committee that they have \$8,748.29 left in this Fiscal Year. Chair recommends spending the remainder of the funds on fill dirt. He suggests requesting 40 loads of fill dirt.

CM Hann/Harvey Moves to recommend that the Committee use up to \$8,000.00 in this Fiscal Year to purchase fill dirt from the Blue Goose Mine, to be delivered by a vendor at the Eagles Nest Trailhead. All Ayes (5-0)

CM Wilbur suggests meeting at the trailhead before the vendor delivers the dirt and mark the areas to dump. CM Harvey suggested allocating some of the remainder of funds to reimburse volunteers for fuel used at the ENT. CM Wilbur states he would like to see the berm repaired before the ENT is open. Chair states he would like to see the invasive species removed, as well as water (fire well). CM Wilbur suggests seeking a grant to bring water to the site an artesian well or a dry hydrant. CM Hann suggests making a backup motion in case the above motion does not work.

CM Hann/Wilbur moves to recommend that in the event that the fill dirt cannot be purchased, the Committee purchase 1 bike repair stand from the Park Catalog and one Meridian Gazebo (12'x20') from yardistryies.com with a cost not to exceed \$8,000.00. All Ayes (5-0)

## c. Cameron Preserve Sign Update & Instillation Plan

Chair began by showing the map of where he would like to see the signs. CM Hann asks if plans are to show these along the trail, or along the border. Chair states the goal is to place the large signs around the edge, and the remainder internally. He believes in the future; we can improve the trails in Cameron and increase the Scrub Jay population. Chair suggests having a trail day to put up the signs. CM Harvey suggests making a backing for the signs, incase someone kicks them. Chair states he will work on developing a list of needed materials to be discussed at the ENT workday. CM Hann suggests replacing the smaller signs around the Cameron Preserve.

#### d. Fiscal Year 21/22 Funds to be Spent

Secretary Kohler informed the Committee he had found a bike repair stand he thought the committee may be interested in. They cost \$1,830.00 per unit. Chair suggests purchasing Horse troughs with the remaining funds. CM Harvey states the suggested trough is too high. She suggests getting a smaller one that can be filled and emptied on each use. Chair suggests getting a pavilion or kiosk in the next fiscal year. CM Hann asks if the committee minds if he reaches out to the forestry department to discuss the possibility of recutting the firebreaks in the Cameron Preserve.

#### e. Next Field Event - TBD

Chair suggests making Saturday September 10<sup>th</sup> the next trail day. He recommends meeting at the ENT at 9 AM to plan the delivery of dirt. CM Hann states he has green marking paint. Chair suggests everyone bring flags and stakes to the meeting.

## 8. OLD/NEW BUSINESS

a. <u>Board Member Comments:</u> CM Harvey states she would like to do a poker horse ride in November or December. It would entail a few things on and off the horse. She would start at her house, go into the Jordan Scrub Sanctuary, go to the ENT and finish with a breakfast. CM Hann suggests combining it with a hash ride. CM Harvey states she would like to do a casual ride open to all skill levels. She is unsure of how many people will come but will request sponsorship from the local feed stores.

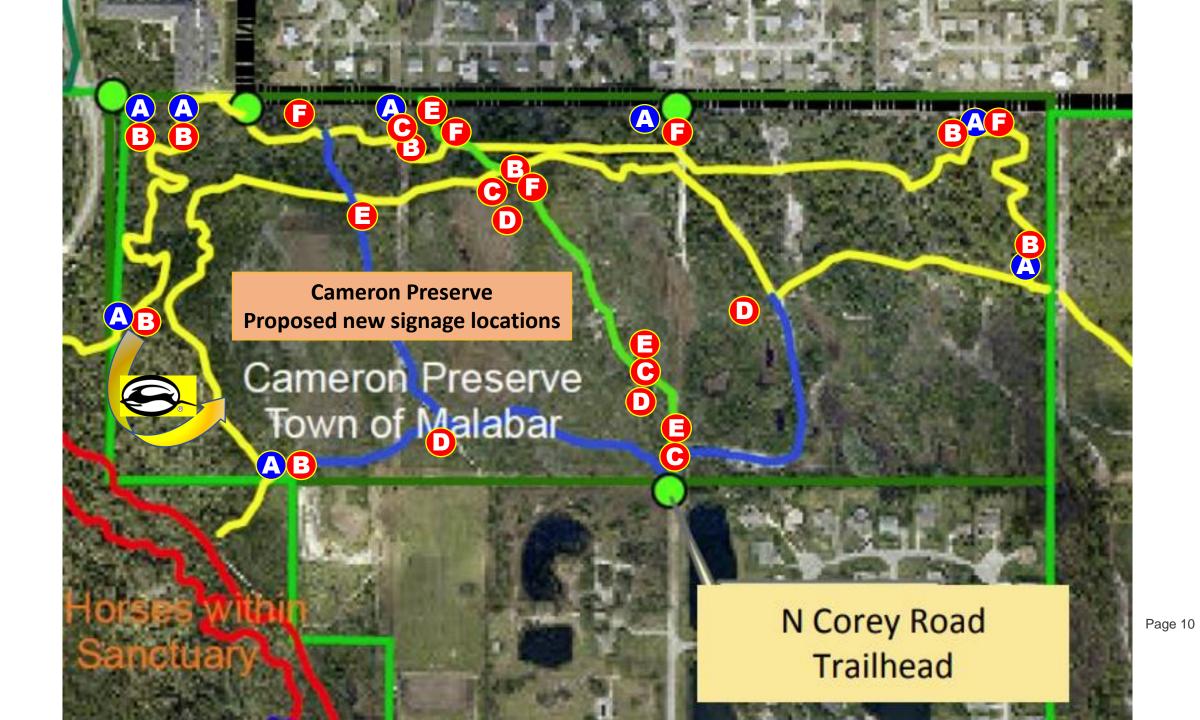
