This meeting of the Malabar Trails and Greenways Committee was held at Town Hall at 2725 Malabar Road.

Meeting called to order at 6:10 P.M. Prayer and Pledge led by Chair Thompson.

> Chair requests clarification on where the Magnolia Trees were planted. VC Hann states they are on the secret trail and placed on the west end.

Trail, Kiosk and Firebreak Conditions

VC Hann states the trails are open and running well. Liaison Smith suggests a trail day to trim face and ankle slappers before the spring season begins.

Cameron Preserve Update b.

VC Hann stated that the group was able to build all the directional signs and install 7 of them. We also installed a few Impala logos for the Impala trail. The rest of the signs are ready to be installed at the next workday.

C. **Purchase Prefabricated Pavilion for Cameron Preserve**

Secretary Kohler states that the Parks and Rec Board initially recommended purchasing 2 pavilions, one for Eschenberg Park, and one for the Cameron Preserve. Due to budget constraints, they have selected to place only one at Eschenberg Park. CM Wilbur offers to run his tractor out there at a workday to create new trails. Chair Thompson states he will request permission from Council at the 2.6 RTCM. Chair Thompson states he would like to see a small wooden pavilion at the entrance of the Preserve at the North end of Corey Road. Hopefully the Page 4 location will keep it from being included in a burn. He then shows a 12'x16' wooden pavilion available at COSTCO. He suggests the T&GC build an elevated deck and

place the pavilion above it. VC Hann asks how high it should go? If it stays under 30" a guardrail would not be required. General discussion about the specific building plans ensued. VC Hann states we could build this in a day. Build the base and plant the pavilion on top. Chair shows a video of the pavilion. CM Wilbur and Liaison Smith both expressed concerns this pavilion may not be high enough quality for a public park. CM Wilbur states he will ask dockside builders to quote us for one. CM Wilbur asks if there are any grants available? Secretary Kohler states he will research.

d. Eagles Nest Trailhead Update

Chair asks what can we do at ENT? CM Wilbur states CM Vail informed him dirt was moved. CM Wilbur states we should get this project. Secretary Kohler states he will request both CM Vail, Chief Foley and TM Stinnett attend the next meeting to try and finalize the plan for this area. Chair states the swale needs to go in before we put the fence in. VC Hann states the swale will go in well before the gate and fence. He expresses frustration that we have waited years for a master plan to install the culverts.

CM Wilbur/VC Hann move to purchase another 20' culvert. (All Ayes).

Ask Tom/Matt for final date of when dirt will come in.

e. South Brevard Master Plan – Stakeholder Pre-Scoping Meeting

Chair Thompson gave the background on this topic. He states the idea has morphed from the Marie Street connector to a renewal of all 7 projects. He then went over some of the slides presented by the SCTPO. The Town of Malabar will be hosting the meeting. A feasibility study will be conducted to determine the applicability of the connection to G/V. Chair states the goal of the plan is connectivity of existing trails. VC suggests requesting including Palm Bay, West Melbourne, and Melbourne. CM Wilbur states a great example of the goal we have is the St. Sebastian Preserve. In connects with several other areas and is a trail hub.



- Space Coast TPO is in the process of developing a Scope of Services for the South Brevard Trails Master Plan

Main goals of the South Brevard Trails Master Plan

- Develop a priority trail network for South Brevard that builds upon prior trail projects and planning
- Develop policy and funding recommendations for implementation
- Development of a methodology to prioritize the trail network
- Development of a list of short-term, mid-term, and long-term trail connections, alignments, improvements, and innovations
- Development of branding for the Al Tuttle and new trail connection with Indian River County
- Initial Alignment Analysis of priority trail segments











Possible Paved Trail Connector Projects Submitted by TOM T&GC in April 2019 to SCTPO Annual Call for Projects Consideration **A Great Trail System Provides Connectivity to Towns & Places**

The following trail projects were submitted to the SCTPO (Space Coast Transportation Planning Organization):

- 1. Al Tuttle TOM G-V Paved Connector Trail This north-south trail follows the established route of the South Brevard Linear Trail south into Grant-Valkaria. Most of the way, the trail follows the Town of Malabar Marie St. ROW; however, in more northerly portions, the paved trail will be located on private property previously designated for public trail use.
- 2. Tillman Canal NS Paved Connector Trail Malabar Road at FPL Powerline, running under / along powerline north to Tillman Canal (south shore) with new pedestrian / bicycle bridge to cross canal, continuing trail north from north shore of Tillman canal to Port Malabar Road (site of existing pedestrian crossing aligned with existing paved trail north to L3Harris.
- 3. Turkey Creek Paved Connector Trail This project is for a paved ADA specification trail (like the Al Tuttle Trail) to connect to the existing Al Tuttle Trail at its most northeastern point in Malabar and then runs across the boundary canal via a new pedestrian / bicycle bridge, with the trail continuing north along a City of Palm Bay drainage ditch to Goode Park at Turkey Creek.
- 4. Cameron Paved Connector Trail North Corey Rd. at end of pavement running northwest through Cameron

 Preserve (paralleling green trail past CTS) to Al Tuttle Trail near where east-west run along border canal turns norther 19




The following trail projects were also submitted to the SCTPO (Space Coast Transportation Planning Organization):

- 5. Briar Creek Paved Connector Trail Briar Creek (Brook Hollow) existing sidewalk across bridge to existing trail crossing, then running on south side of Briar Creek Blvd. to Glenbrooke at Palm Bay sidewalk, and finally east to Al Tuttle trail behind Glenbrooke where east-west run along border canal turns north
- 6. Tillman Canal EW Paved Connector Trail This project is for a paved ADA specification trail to mirror the Al Tuttle Trail in design and is to run west from the south shore of the Tillman Canal, where the FPL power line crosses the Tillman Canal, along the Tillman Canal and under the Babcock St. bridge, continuing along the Tillman canal to the City of Palm Bay 9.62-acre property being planned for a mountain bike theme public park, near Norbert Rd. NE. This trail project follows the south shore of the Tillman Canal and most of the trail's location would fall under the management of the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District.
- 7. Jordan Scrub EW Paved Connector Trail This project is for a paved ADA specification trail to mirror the Al Tuttle Trail in design and is to run west from at or near US Highway 1 at its intersection with Jordan Blvd., cross the railroad tracks at the established crossing, continue on the north side of the Town of Malabar ROW of Jordan Blvd., ending at Marie St. with connection there to the also proposed future Al Tuttle Malabar Grant-Valkaria Paved Connector Trail.




