Also a commercial enterprise - trucks full of canoes, teach wind surfing. Then a rave on the island, called the BCSO and there was nothing they could do. They are opposed to this.

Skip Hard, drainage, 2560 Hard Lane, drainage issues were listed. Have they been seen? Yes, establish an inventory of culverts in town. Hopefully they will list all of them

Wayne Abare, 2530 Rocky Pt Rd, is against the boat launch. He shows the land owned by Skora. He called town and asked for sign to put up the sign. There is some precedent for that to be a no parking area. Just south of Malabar limit, there is a mile or two available for launching. Wanted to give history of area. Mayor said he put up signs way back when and there were five.

Christine Filiberto, lived there 25 years, is the first house and gets all the riff raff – there is always trash, they bring trailers and try and launch. If the launch area goes forward, who is pushing this? County? No. Hope they can stop it. What is town going to do to protect residents? It has been a nightmare.

CM Korn said a similar request was made 12 years ago and had similar problem, CM Vail asked resident if they could develop it and monitor it and maintain it and have security. CM Krieger asked how they found out about this. She scanned Dick Korn's website. No one in neighborhood knew about this.

Wayne will contact him. To get signs back up.

Drew Thompson is not from Rocky Pt Rd. He would like to have access It is not a whole lot of property. Non-motorized launch area. No overnight parking, no motorized watercraft. This would provide the rest of the residents an access point. He would like to have a win-win project. No boat ramp, keep it clean and keep it clear. It would lock down what is now open game. As a citizen he thinks this could be worked out for the benefit of all.

Bob Wilbur, 2500 Glatter Road wants to support this water front access. All the areas south of Malabar have been armored with rocks (after storms in 2004). It is not currently being patrolled; once it is designated for this legitimate use, the sheriff can patrol. It is a real good thing, providing a blueway/greenway connection.

# Speaker Cards:

**Mr. Moia** representing property owner of 24-acre east of three vacant parcels at SE corner of Malabar and Weber Roads.

**Skip Hard**, stated that the Town needs to get right-of-way from the three lots on SE corner of Weber and Malabar – who is going to ensure that? Re: proposed changes to R/LC, we have many absentee property owners – how do they get noticed. Clerk explained that there would be multiple notices sent to parcel owners via USPS as well as legal ads and property postings. This is a long process.

Juliana Hirsch, asked to pass stating her comments may be premature. She reiterated her previous statement to Council to not decrease the density from six (6 units per acre) to four (4 units per acre) in RLC.

Chair of P&Z Board Pat Reilly, then presented the Board's recommendation. He stated the last FLUM update was done in 1994. They have been working on this for the last five years. He is giving the top view of the Board's recommendation and asked if Council was looking for joint workshop to discuss this in detail? He asked if they wanted to break it up into sections. Or move forward with it as is?

CM Korn had some concerns over changing land use on Babcock that abutted residential uses. Mr. Reilly gave the rationale for their recommendation.

CM Vail said to CM Korn that this is just a presentation and at a later date they can go into workshop so it can be discussed in detail.

Mayor said P&Z should break it down. CM Vail said it should be discussed at a workshop – CB Ball agreed. CM Vail said he would like to see the added language underlined and the deleted areas shown with strike throughs for the workshop.

CM Ball said move forward with a WS – can EELs ever sell it. Mayor said conservation designations should be their first items for action.

CM Korn said lets define the workshop rules. CM Krieger said it should just be Council at first. CM Vail said there should be one representative from P&Z Board. Attorney said no final action is taken at a workshop. Generally not open for public input. He said input from staff is appropriate and perhaps a representative from the P&Z Board as well.

Conditional Uses.

The PZ Board discussed Table 1-3.2 at the last few PZ Meetings, they reviewed this Table 1-3.2 and made suggestions to remove the "C's" which represents Conditional Use that are listed under the Community Facilities in reference to Churches, Synagogues, and Other Places of Worship in the Town of Malabar.

This suggestion came as a result of persons walking into PZ Meetings presenting a scenario of purchasing a residential home in a designated residential area and converting it into a place of Worship. The PZ Board explained the issues of roads, water/septic availability, traffic flow, and the process of the Board of Adjustment for a Conditional Use and notification of the 500 ft. radius package. The Board explained that adjacent neighbors to this projected use do not want traffic and commercial buildings in a residential area. The PZ Board always presented to the "scenario seekers" that there are plenty of areas in Malabar that do permit these use. It was after this that the PZ Board suggested to have this as an Agenda Item to revise/remove the conditional use in residential areas for Churches, Synagogues and Other Places of Worship and those that wish to have this use would look under permitted areas.

It is the suggestion of the PZ Board to remove the "C's" (Conditional Use) in the following residential zoning districts RR-65, RS-21, RS-15, RS-10, RM-4, and RM-6. There were also corrections made on Table 1-3.2 Land Use by Districts under "Community Facilities" under the, "OI" zoning for Churches, Synagogues and Other Places of Worship (P,A,1) per foot notes, and Educational Institutions (C,A,1) to make larger #1's not small #1's per footnotes. This is noted on attached Table 1-3.2.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR REVISION OF BUILDING, FENCE, ROOFING, ELECTRICAL, PLUMBING, GAS, MECHANICAL, SWIMMING POOL, FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEMS, SIGNS AND IRRIGATION SYSTEM PERMIT FEES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, before an applicant can obtain a permit as prescribed in the Town of Malabar Building Code, the appropriate fees must be paid; and

**WHEREAS**, these fees have been determined to be necessary and sufficient to compensate for the time and expense of processing the various permits; and

WHEREAS, after a review of the current building permit fees the Malabar Town Council has determined that a rate adjustment is appropriate at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the following fees are hereby established for building, fence, roofing, electric, plumbing, gas, mechanical, swimming pool, fire protection system, sign and irrigation system permits in the Town of Malabar.

### **BUILDING PERMITS:**

For any work requiring a building permit as prescribed in the Town of Malabar Building Code the following cost of said permits shall be based on the following:

- (1) For the purpose of determining the building permit fee, the estimated <u>value</u> cost of construction shall be determined by the Building Official using Florida Building Code formulas.
- (2) Permit fees are as follows:
  - a. Base permit fee \$55.00 30.00 plus:
  - b. Inspection fee(s) shall be computed based on the following table:

\$100,001.00 to \$500,000.00	\$1,285.00 460.00 for the first \$100,000.00 plus \$5.00 3.00 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof, up to and including \$500,000.00
\$500,001.00 and up	\$3,285.00 1660.00 for the first \$500,000.00 plus \$3.00 2.00 for each additional thousand or fraction thereof.

# (3) Additional fees:

- a. Moving a building or structure \$100.00
- b. Demolition of any building or structure \$100.00 50.00
- c. Mobile home setup \$100.00 50.00.
- d. Construction of any parking lot where no building construction is permitted in association with the parking lot construction—\$75.00.

# (4) Plan Review Fees:

- a. Building Construction: when valuation of the construction exceeds one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) a plan review fee equal to fifty (50) per cent of the building permit fee established above shall be charged.
- b. All building construction EXCEPT single-family and duplex dwellings: when the valuation of the construction exceeds one thousand dollars (\$1000.00), in addition to the fee established in 4(a) above, an additional plan checking fee shall be charged equal to twenty-five (25) per cent of the building permit fee established above for the life safety plan review pursuant to Florida Statute 633.
- c. If plans for a single project have received two (2) plan reviews and the plans are not approved for construction, an additional plan checking fee equal to one half (1/2) of the original plan checking fee shall be paid before any further plan review is done. This fee shall be applied for each subsequent review for the project.
- d. Placement of temporary construction trailer- \$100.00 40.00.
- e. Placement of temporary mobile home or RV while constructing home is limited to a period of six (6) months and requires a \$500.00 refundable cash bond.
- f. Review/verification to re-issue copy of approved building plans \$50.00 30.00.

- (5) <u>Double Fee</u>: pursuant to Malabar Code of Ordinances, Chap 6, Sec 6-7, when work which requires a permit is started without first obtaining a permit, the fee specified for such permit shall be doubled or \$50, whichever is greater. The payment of such double fee shall not relieve any person from fully complying with the requirements of the Florida Building Code 2001 Ed. or from any other code or ordinance of the Town. The Town shall also have the right to pursue any other actions or penalties prescribed by law.
- (6) <u>Re-inspection Fee</u>: in the event it becomes necessary to make a re-inspection, due to improper work or permitted work not being ready, the contractor shall pay a re-inspection fee of <u>fifty dollars</u> (\$50.00) thirty dollars (\$30.00) for the first inspection, fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the second inspection and one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each additional re-inspection thereafter.

# Sign Permits:

For any work requiring a sign permit, the cost of said permit shall be as prescribed below:

- (1) Basic permit fee \$30.00 plus:
- (2) Inspection fee signs shall be calculated at one dollar \$1.00/per sq. ft of sign area. This calculation shall be based on the largest sign area in the case of a sign with more than one face. Minimum: \$30.00.
