

### **Brevard County:**

- There is a 70% chance of subtropical or tropical development in the Bahamas this weekend. The system would be moving northeast away from Florida and no direct impacts are expected, although the rip current threat is expected to increase.
- The Canaveral Port Authority opened Jetty Park at 50% for beach access parking only, no campground stays permitted. Click here to view additional information.
- Brevard County campgrounds Manatee Hammock, Titusville; Wickham Park, Melbourne; and Long Point, just north of Sebastian; are open at no more than 50% capacity. Every other campsite can be occupied.
- Brevard County government offices will reopen on Monday, May 18, with social distancing measures in place. Some offices will operate by appointment only.

To complete the required pre-screening, call (321) 726-2770. The line will be staffed from 8 AM to 3 PM Monday through Friday. • The Palm Bay Police Department lobby will reopen by appointment only Monday, May 18. Lobby hours are 9 AM to 3 PM Monday through Friday. Walk-ups will not be accepted. For non-emergency service, call 321-952-3456. Palm Shores Town Hall is closed to the public; requests for permits and inspections should be called to 321-242-4555 to schedule an appointment.

# **EOC Partners Status** Rockledge Building Department permit pick-up, issuance, and payment is by appointment only. Plan review will continue as normal. • All beach activities are permitted, but in groups of 5 or less. Satellite Beach • No congregating on boardwalks or beach access areas is permitted. Titusville • City Hall is accepting entry by appointment only and guests are required to wear a mask, respond to five health questions, and have their temperature checked. • On May 18, City Hall will reopen to the public. City of West Melbourne offices are open to the general public, although citizens are encouraged to West Melbourne continue to access City services primarily through telephone at 321-727-7700, or by e-mail at info@westmelbourne.org. • The municipal tennis courts at Bryant Adams Park have re-opened. The Space Coast Field of Dreams, splash pad, and skate park within West Melbourne Community Park remain closed. Parks and Recreation programs, classes and facility reservations are currently being taken for reservations on and after July 1, subject to potential cancellation.
