## CDC Guidance for Personal Activities

### VENTURING OUT TO THE BANK?

- Ask about options for telephone or virtual meeting to use bank services.
- Use drive-thru banking services, automated teller machines (ATMs), or mobile banking apps for routine transactions that do not require face-to-face assistance.
- Look for any extra prevention practices being implemented by the bank, such as plexiglass barriers for tellers or bankers, staff wearing cloth face coverings, or physical distancing signs in the lobby.
- Wear a cloth face covering when doing any in-person exchanges and unable to stay at least 6-feet apart from other people.
- Use hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol after any deposit, withdraw, exchange, drive-thru visit, or use of an ATM.
- Wash your hands thoroughly when you arrive home or to your destination where a restroom is available.

- Brevard County Farmers Market is open Thursdays from 3 PM to 6 PM. Links to each of the vendors can be found at [Brevard County Farmers Market](#).
  - Through August 31 when SNAP/EBT is used, they will double the amount purchased. The amount purchased will be given in the form of orange tokens, and can be used with most all of the vendors.
  - The matching dollars will be given in the form of green tokens and can only be used for fresh produce or plants that produce fruits, veggies, or herbs.
  - There is currently no limit on the match and tokens do not expire.
- Vacation Rentals:
  - County plan has been approved by the state
  - Residents from hot spots: New York, New Jersey, and Connecticut, are required to stay in 14-day self-isolation.

- The Agency for Health Care Administration issued Emergency Rule [59AER20-4](#) and Emergency Rule [59AER20-5](#) requiring nursing home and assisted living facility staff to be tested for COVID-19 every two weeks with testing resources provided by the state and submit the test results to their employer/facility. The facility must keep copies of all staff testing documentation on site.
