Prescribed Fire Planned for Malabar Scrub Sanctuary on February 12th

Malabar, FL – A 30-acre prescribed fire within the Malabar Scrub Sanctuary (East) is planned from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Wednesday, February 12th, 2020 by Brevard County's Environmentally Endangered Lands Program in coordination with Brevard County Fire Rescue, Florida Forest Service and the Florida Park Service.

The Malabar Scrub Sanctuary is located to the north and east of Malabar Community Park on Malabar Rd. in Malabar, FL.

Prescribed fires involve the careful application of fire by professionals under specific weather and fuel conditions to achieve environmental resource management goals. Benefits include the reduction of wildfire risk, habitat restoration and the recycling of nutrients back into the soil.
