

Potential Covid-19 Exposure Notification

Unfortunately, one or more members of the Malabar Fire Department have tested positive for Covid-19. Aggressive actions have been taken to reduce the spread within the Department including additional PPE requirements while on shift, decontamination efforts for Department Facilities and equipment, and testing of all members of the Department.

While none of the members of the Department were showing signs or symptoms of illness at the prior <u>Council Meeting on June 15th, 2020</u> and social distancing efforts were in place, we felt it was necessary to notify as many people as possible that may have come into contact with Fire Department Staff or others in attendance of the meeting or subsequently. This notification does <u>not</u> mean that you have been exposed but is intended to provide you the opportunity to make informed decisions about your individual risk of exposure.

<u>Free drive-through testing</u> with no appointment required is available at the Eastern Florida State College campus 7 days a week from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. located at:

Palm Bay, FL 32909
(use the entrance from San Filippo Dr. SE & Jupiter Blvd)
For individuals over the age of 18 regardless of symptoms
Photo ID is required limit passengers to 5 and only those being tested

Symptoms of Covid-19 include fever of 100.1 or higher, cough, and shortness of breath, diarrhea and sore throat. Those experiencing emergency warning signs such as difficulty breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, new confusion or inability to arouse, bluish lips or face, should immediately seek medical attention.
