RESOLUTION 03-2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA TO PROVIDE FOR THE AMENDMENT TO THE ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO PROVIDE COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION TO RECORD NON-ADVALORUM STORMWATER UTILITY MONIES WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND; PROVIDING FOR SEPARATE GENERAL LEDGER ACCOUNT NUMBERS; PROVIDING FOR SEPARATE BANK ACCOUNTS FOR STORMWATER REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Malabar of Brevard County, Florida, has adopted Ordinance 08-2000, establishing a Stormwater Utility for the Town of Malabar, Brevard County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has changed the accounting system software to Quick Books Pro 2013 and desires to provide accounting for the revenues and expenditures of the stormwater utility fees within the General Fund similar to the method used for Local Option Gas Tax; and providing an easier and more transparent method of recording same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1

The Town Council of Malabar, Brevard County, Florida, authorizes the Town Clerk/Treasurer to record the revenues and expenditures from the non-advalorum stormwater utility fees within the General Fund. The funds will be identified by separate account numbers and their use restricted to stormwater related projects.

Section 2

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

Section 3

This Resolution shall take effect retroactively to October 1, 2013
