RESOLUTION 4-2012

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE FLORIDA LEAGUE OF CITIES ADVOCACY ON OPPOSING CS/HB 809 AND CS/SB 1060 BOTH PROPOSING LEGISLATION THAT WOULD ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT FOR PROVIDERS TO MAINTAIN ACCURATE ADDRESS INFORMATION FOR JURISDICTIONAL TAX DISTRIBUTIONS; OPPOSE THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION THAT ALSO REMOVES THE STATE'S REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN THE JURISDICTIONAL DATABASE; OPPOSE THE PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE DEFINITIONS; OPPOSE THE PROPOSED LOSS OF TAX REVENUE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- **WHEREAS,** the State legislature specifically authorized Communications Service Tax as a revenue for municipalities and providers paid municipalities directly; and
- **WHEREAS**, the State legislature changed the method of collection in 2000 and expressed to municipalities that the State was better positioned to collect the tax directly from the provider and then distribute to the municipalities; and
- **WHEREAS,** the State legislature is now proposing changes that would adversely affect the municipalities tax collection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:
