## **RESOLUTION 113-2011**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (NIMS); PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF THE BREVARD COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT AS THE NIMS IMPLEMENTATION COORDINATOR; PROVIDING FOR MALABAR COMPLIANCE TO THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT PLAN; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, Homeland Security Presidential Directive HSPD-5 was established on February 28, 2003 the National Incident Management System (NIMS); and
- whereas, the NIMS established a single comprehensive approach to domestic incident management to ensure that all levels of government across the Nation have the capability to work efficiently and effectively together using a national approach to domestic incident management; and
- whereas, the NIMS provides a consistent nationwide approach for Federal, State, and local governments to work together to prepare for and respond to, and recover from domestic incidents regardless of the cause, size or complexity; and
- whereas, the NIMS provides compatibility among Federal, State, and local governments to include a core set of concepts, principles, terminology and technologies covering the incident command system, unified command, training, management of resources and reporting; and
- whereas, beginning on October 1, 2005 all Federal, State, Local and Tribal departments and agencies were to adopt the NIMS to the extent provided by law, for providing Federal preparedness assistance through grants, contracts, or other activities to local governments; and
- WHEREAS, local governments must adopt to the NIMS compliance in order to be eligible to accept Federal preparedness funding; and
- WHEREAS, this resolution recognizes Brevard County Emergency Management as the NIMS implementation coordinator for this effort countywide; and
- whereas, the Brevard County Sheriff's Office, Brevard County Fire Rescue, Brevard County Health Department, and all agencies participating in the Brevard county comprehensive Emergency Management Plan are required to use the National Incident Management Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:

Page 2 Resolution 113-2011

Section 1. That the Town of Malabar hereby adopts the National Incident Management System (NIMS) program as required by law.

- Section 2. That the Town of Malabar hereby approves the Brevard County Emergency Management Department as the countywide emergency management coordinator.
- Section 3. That the Town Clerk is directed to send a copy to the Brevard County Emergency Management Department upon adoption.
- That this resolution shall be effective upon adoption. Section 4.
