RESOLUTION 16-2013

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, IMPOSING A MORITORIUM ON NAMING THE ALTERNATE 1 AND 2 ON THE PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD UNTIL SUCH TIME AS PROCEDURES ARE ADOPTED BY COUNCIL; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Malabar Town Council has been working on establishing procedures for all the Town's Boards and Committees; and

WHEREAS, Malabar Town Council has not reached consensus on the method of appointing alternate 1 and 2 on the Planning and Zoning Board; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution is to impose a moratorium on naming an alternate 1 or 2 on the Planning and Zoning Board until procedures are approved by Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Town Council of Malabar, Brevard County, Florida, hereby affirms the above statements..

Section 2. The Town Council of Malabar hereby authorizes and directs the Town Clerk to notify the Planning and Zoning Secretary of this decision and provide a copy of this Resolution.

<u>Section 3.</u> All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. <u>Section 4.</u> This resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
