

RESOLUTION NO. 17-2012

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR COUNCIL APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF THE FIVE (5) YEAR PERMIT BEFORE SUBMITTAL DEADLINE; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF APPLICATION PERMIT FEE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Malabar is required by the State to have a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for discharge of Stormwater; and

WHEREAS, the current Five (5) year Permit is due to expire in December 2012 and the renewal application must be submitted 180 days prior to that date; and

WHEREAS, the permit application has an application fee of \$5,625.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The Town Council of Malabar, Brevard County, Florida, hereby approves and directs that the application be submitted prior to July 7, 2012.

Section 2. The Town Council of Malabar, Brevard County, Florida, hereby authorizes and directs that the application fee of \$5,625.00 be submitted with the application.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.






