RESOLUTION 07-2007

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA; RELATING TO PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFLICT RESOLUTION PROCEDURES INITIATED BY BREVARD COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 04- 182 initiating the conflict resolution procedures as set forth in Chapter 164 of the Florida Statutes concerning a request that the Town participate in the Law Enforcement Municipal Services Taxing Unit (MSTU); and
