## **RESOLUTION 13-2007**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF BEEKEEPER ROAD AS A NEW MALABAR STREET NAME; PROVIDING THE FORWARDING OF THIS INFORMATION TO BREVARD COUNTY ADDRESS ASSIGNMENT FOR E 9-1-1 EMERGENCY IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR THE POSSIBILITY OF RENAMING; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Malabar has the responsibility of naming rights-of-way within its jurisdiction through coordination with Brevard County Address Assignment for E 9-1-1 purposes; and

**WHEREAS,** Brevard County Address Assignment has approved of Beekeeper Road for an unimproved right of way within Malabar, being more particularly described as follows: Commence at the east side of Corey Road at the northeast corner of Section 12, Township 29, Range 37, head approximately 2600 lineal feet south (of Atz Road), running to the east boundary of Section 12 (what was Old Mission Road east of Corey Road).

WHEREAS, after adoption of this new street name, the Malabar Volunteer Fire Department improvement of said right of way shall be notified of the approved street name, and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the Town of Malabar approves of the new name "Beekeeper Road" for the right-of-way described above.

**SECTION 2.** That the Town of Malabar directs that this resolution be recorded at the Clerk of Courts and a copy be forwarded to Brevard County Address Assignment for input into the E 9-1-1 database and additional copies be sent to the Post Office serving that area, the Supervisor of Elections, and all concerned public safety agencies for their information, and that the proper notations be made on all maps of record.

**SECTION 3.** The naming of this right-of-way for fire fighting response improvements in no way commits the Town to regular maintenance of this unimproved right-of-way.

**SECTION 4.** All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5.** Should any Section, Clause, or Provision of this Resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions or parts of this Resolution.

**SECTION 6.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
