

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-2013**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING "THOMAS M. ESCHENBERG MEMORIAL PARK" FOR THE OFFICIAL NAME FOR THE 17-ACRE CONSERVATION AREA AT 1800 WEBER ROAD, PROVIDING SIGNAGE AND INFORMATION ON HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE TOWN; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows**

**SECTION 1. Adopting Thomas M. Eschenberg Memorial Park as the official name**  
The 17-acre conservation parcel at 1800 Weber Road shall be known as the "Thomas M. Eschenberg Memorial Park" located at 1800 Weber Road, south of Malabar Road with signage and information posted at the site with his contributions and is hereby designated as an official municipal conservation park belonging to the Town of Malabar.

**SECTION 2. Conflict.**  
All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed.

**SECTION 3. Effective date.**  
This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
