

RESOLUTION 22-2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING CERTIFICATION OF ANNUAL STORMWATER UTILITY ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR FY 2014/2015 FOR THE STORMWATER UTILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, an annual assessment roll has been prepared by Brevard County, a summary of which is attached to and made part of this Resolution by reference and labeled Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, a copy of such Annual Stormwater Utility Assessment Roll has been sent to the Brevard County Tax Collector for collection in the same manner as ad valorem taxes are collected; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is satisfied that the annual Stormwater Utility Assessment Roll has been prepared in conformity with the Schedule of Rates and Classifications adopted by the Town Council on August 7, 2000; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The Town Council of Malabar, Brevard County, Florida, hereby ratifies, confirms, and certifies that the annual Stormwater Utility Assessment Roll for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2014, is in conformity with the Schedule of Rates adopted by the Town Council on August 7, 2000 and approves the estimated assessment of \$68,796.59.

Section 2. Those stormwater utility assessments imposed during fiscal year beginning October 1, 2014, shall be budgeted along with 97,194.00 from preceding years to create a budget of \$165,991.00 for the Town's Stormwater Utility.

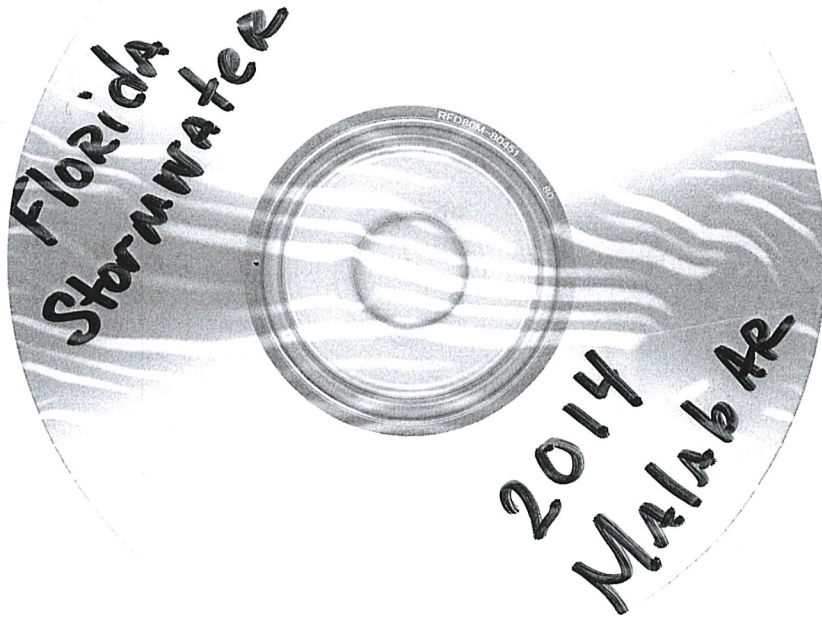
