

Happy February! The groundhog didn't see his shadow this year, which means early spring is coming. If you believe in the Groundhog Day legend that is. This winter season has been very wet, but the National Oceanic And Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) is predicting that Florida will experience more above average rainfall through the spring months. What does this mean for Malabar residents? For those who live on dirt/gravel roads, it might take a few days after a rain for Public Works to come maintain and grade the roads. Rain can make the ground too wet to grade and any fill that is put down will get washed away. Usually after a heavy rain Public Works will wait for the roads to dry out, and that will cause some delay in road maintenance. We thank our residents for having patience, because this season has been wetter than normal and it is still not over yet.

Q: How do I apply for a building permit?

A: Go to the Building Department page on the Town of Malabar website and click on "To Apply or Pay for a building permit". Under the section "Building Permit Application" click on "Building Permit" and you can create your application from there.



Q: How do I set up waste services as a resident in Malabar?

A: Waste Pro provides waste services for the Town of Malabar. Residents can request service and new bins on Waste Pro's website at https://www.wasteprousa.com/malabar/. You can also request bulk pickups for debris and report missed pickups on their website.
