Malabar Staff Cleans Up Riverfront

On January 7th, The Town of Malabar Public Works Department removed 7,000lbs of construction debris that was illegally dumped in the area of Goat Creek-Indian River Lagoon and US1. This was done as a priority action to remove the illegally dumped debris before it could be washed into the Indian River Lagoon. To avoid issues like this in the future, whether you hire a contractor or do-it-yourself for home repairs, be sure to acquire a dumpster to collect and dispose of your projects properly.

Illegal dumping and any suspicious activity should be immediately reported to law enforcement, non-emergency dispatch, 321-633-7162. "Caught in the Act" reports have a greater success of fines and prosecution. Together we can protect our Lagoon and keep our Rights of Ways clear of unsightly trash and debris.
