RESOLUTION 03-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SAVE OUR INDIAN RIVER LAGOON LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE SURTAX INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Malabar Electors voted in support of the countywide levy of the one-half cent surtax for the *Save Our Indian River Lagoon* local infrastructure in the referendum held on November 8, 2016 with a 55% to 45% ratio; and

WHEREAS, this Interlocal Agreement refers to Brevard County Ordinance No. 16-15 that provides language for how the revenue generated by the surtax is used and distributed; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Malabar desires to participate in the Interlocal agreement to provide a coordinated process for restoring the water quality in the Indian River Lagoon with appropriate stormwater improvement projects funded by these revenues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The Town Council of Malabar, Brevard County, Florida, hereby asserts the above statements are true and correct as stated in the Interlocal Agreement attached as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. The Town Council of Malabar, Brevard County, Florida, hereby directs that the Clerk forward the executed document to Brevard County Administration.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


